

The Christian Network School

Report: May 2016

We just returned from a 3 week trip to Colombia, during which we met with the group of Christian teachers at a conference and training event (May 12-14, 2016) that was held at the farm in Pereira, together with the 12 students who are taking the 1 year Bible study program there.



Over the past year 3 teachers have withdrawn from the program to take up employment elsewhere, so we now have 12 teachers active in the program, plus some others who are in training, reaching out to a total of about 45 schools representing some 220 classes and 7000 children being taught weekly. (Last year: 50 schools, 300 groups, 9400 children). We estimate that for the whole of 2016, the program will cost about \$22'000 US dollars.

At the conference we shared various materials for children that have been developed, not just by ourselves, but by some of the Colombian teachers themselves. The teachers also shared testimonies of their experiences with children and teachers in their schools.

17 teachers came to the conference, including some who are in training and wishing to join in this ministry. At this time there are more open doors than the teachers can commit to, so we need to pray the Lord would raise up more faithful teachers with a real heart for this ministry!

We also ask you to pray the teachers would continue presenting the Christian message clearly, and that many boys, girls and their parents and class teachers would come to faith in the Lord. Also that the Lord would continue to provide the resources so this strategic project may continue.
